Let's Learn Together

Did you know . . .

At the 2018 Supreme convention, Section I of the Supreme Administration Manual was distributed to all Supreme Officers, Supreme Past Presidents, State Presidents and Territorial Deputies. This section covered all forms along with a new sample of the Auxiliary By-laws as well as copies of the new promotional material. Instructions on how to use the forms is included. Included in the sample Auxiliary By-laws is a new Order of Business to be used at your meetings.

At this year's Supreme convention, Section II and Section IV of the Supreme Administration manual was distributed to the Supreme Officers, Supreme Past Presidents, State Presidents and Territorial Deputies. Section II covers guidelines when meeting with potential candidates; meeting room setup; a sample auxiliary meeting; the official Columbiette opening and closing prayers; memorial services for a Columbiette, for a husband and also for an immediate family member; Honor Guard guidelines and lastly the offertory procession to be used at your conventions.

Section IV covers all the organizational material used for expansion purposes; procedure on dissolution of an auxiliary; sample State By-laws; and sample Chapter By-laws. Included is IRS information on how to file the 990N form with the IRS and general IRS information.

There is a wealth of information in all three sections. Please make sure your manual is updated with all this new information. As you insert this information, make sure you **DESTROY** all the old material under these sections. State Presidents should make sure their board members, District Deputies, Chapter Presidents and Auxiliary Presidents have these new Sections. We want to make sure anyone who has a manual has all the updated information.





CARING AND SHARING

Retention:

An important part of the membership program for any Auxiliary is retention. Members of this committee should be dedicated to the preservation of the membership. Some tips to help new members feel part of the group when they join an auxiliary are:.

- Keep in touch with your members. If the member has missed a few meetings contact her and let her know she is missed. Ask if everything is alright with her and her family.
- If transportation is an issue, see what members live near each other and perhaps suggest a carpool.
- Introduce all the new members to the membership. Try to appoint the new member to a committee. Make sure she is not sitting alone. Make her feel like she is part of the group and does not feel like an outsider.
- If you have new members at a meeting make sure they know about ongoing committees, and how they work, i.e. meals for Hospice; shoe box project, adopt a family at Christmas, etc.
- Explain correspondence received from other Columbiette levels so they understand what is going on at all levels.
- Wear name badges so everyone gets to know each other.

Thank you! The Columbiettes look forward to continuing our service to church, community and the Knights of Columbus Council for many years to come.




