


New Jersey State Council Columbiettes 64th Annual Convention June 26 - 28, 2020

From Interstate 287 traveling NORTH:

From Interstate 287 Northbound, take Exit 9 (River Road) towards Bound Brook/ Highland Park. Make left off exit and proceed to jug handle turn on right hand side labeled Centennial Avenue. Take Centennial Ave ½ mile and turn left at first traffic light into Embassy Suites parking lot.

From Interstate 287 traveling SOUTH:

From Interstate 287 Southbound, take Exit 9 (River Road) towards Bound Brook/Highland Park. Turn right onto River Road. Make slight right towards Centennial Avenue. Continue onto Centennial Avenue and then turn left onto Kingsbridge Road. Turn left into Embassy Suites.

From New Jersey Turnpike:

Take Exit 10 to Interstate 287 North and follow directions from Interstate 287 North.

From Garden State Parkway traveling NORTH:

Take Exit 127 to Interstate 287 North. Follow directions from Interstate 287 North.


